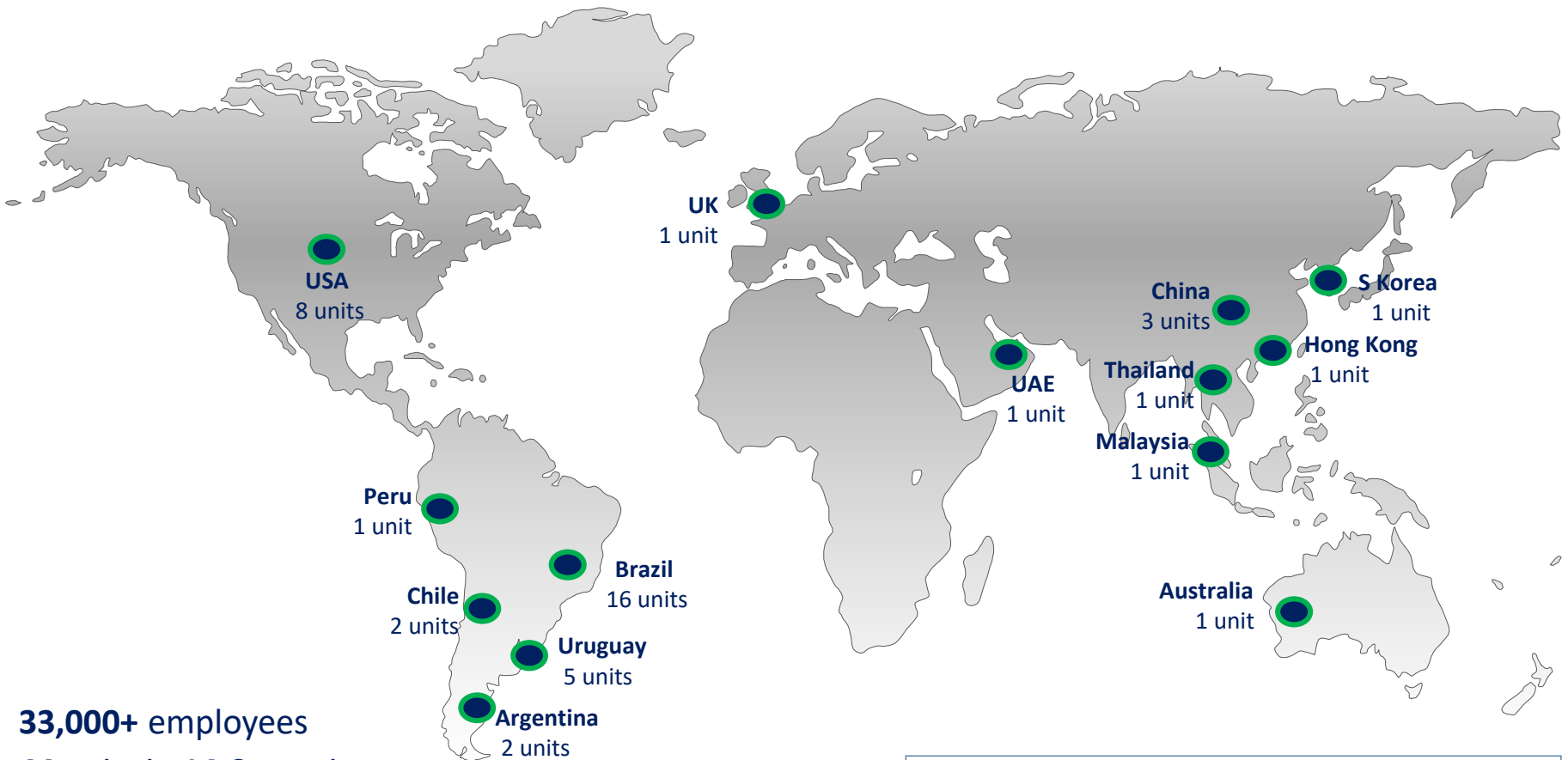

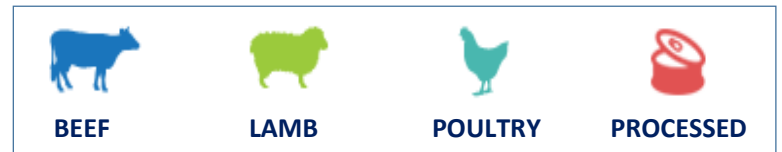

Marfrig Beef | Marfrig Club – Introduction



A Program that encourages and rewards farmers who adopt good social and environmental practices

Promotes the production of sustainable, safe and legal beef. Offers *benefits* to producers, according to the level of conformity by encouraging them to obtain the most modern food production facility certifications and *rewarding* farm animals with good agricultural and livestock practices.

Member farms are classed as BEGGINERS, BRONZE, SILVER, GOLD and PLATINUM depending on the level of achievements against Marfrig Club parameters.

Amazon | 2009 Agreement

Marfrig is a signatory of the **Criteria for Industrial Scale Cattle and Beef Products Operations in the Amazon Biome**, in agreement with **GREENPEACE**

- ✓ Not to source from farms linked with invasion of indigenous land and environmental conservation units
 - ✓ Not to source from farms Black-listed by MTE (Ministry of Labour) linked with forced labour
 - ✓ Not to source from farms Black-listed by IBAMA (Brazilian Environmental Agency) linked with Deforestation and other Environmental Issues
 - ✓ Monitor regularly by satellite all the suppliers located in the Amazon Biome to ensure that animals do not come from newly deforested areas, indigenous land and conservation areas.
-
- ❑ Farms black-listed by IBAMA and MTE are blocked automatically in Marfrig system
 - ❑ Purchases of Cattle are audited by a 3rd company and report is published on annual basis

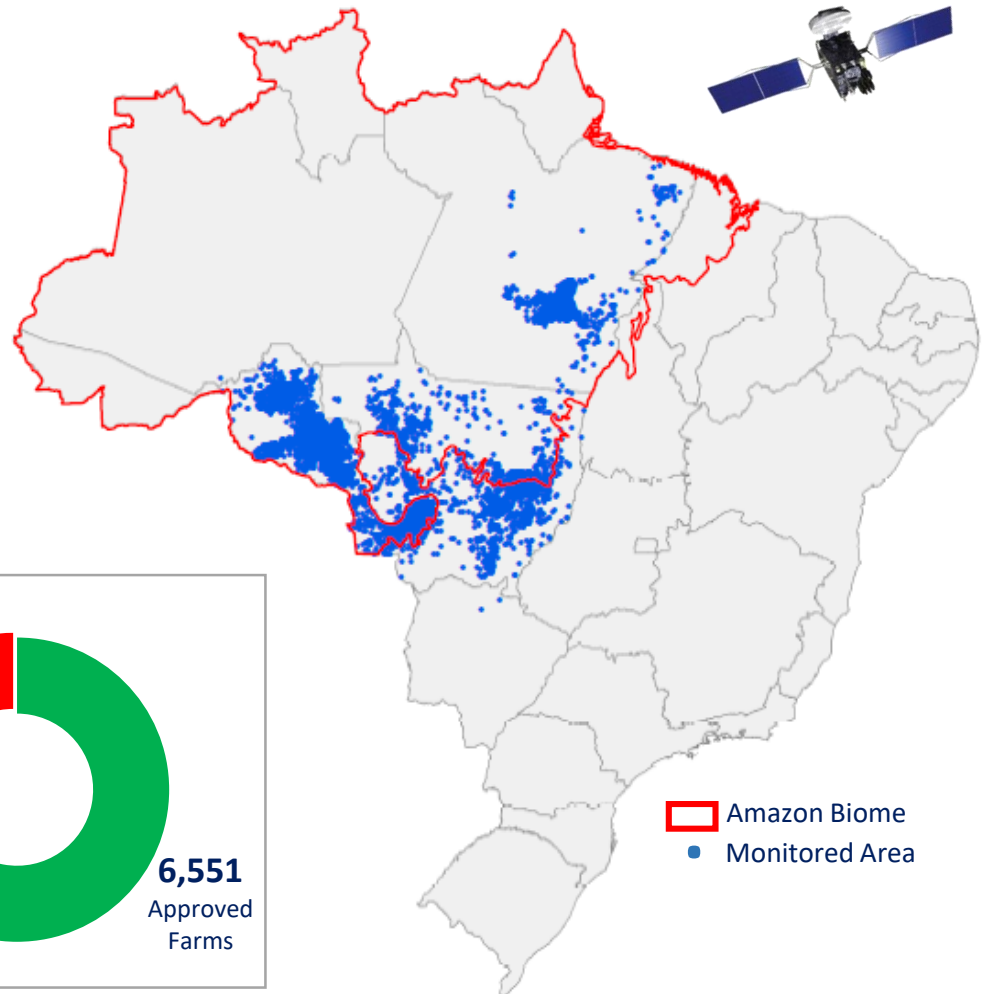
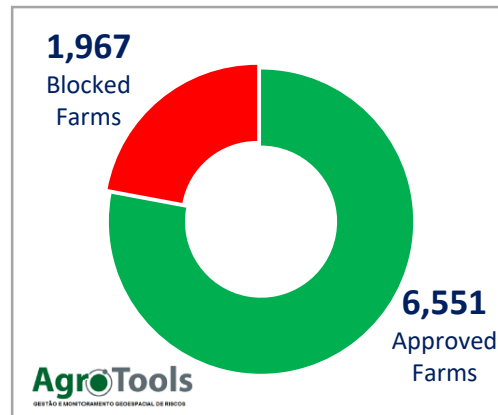

Amazon | Satellite Monitoring Analysis



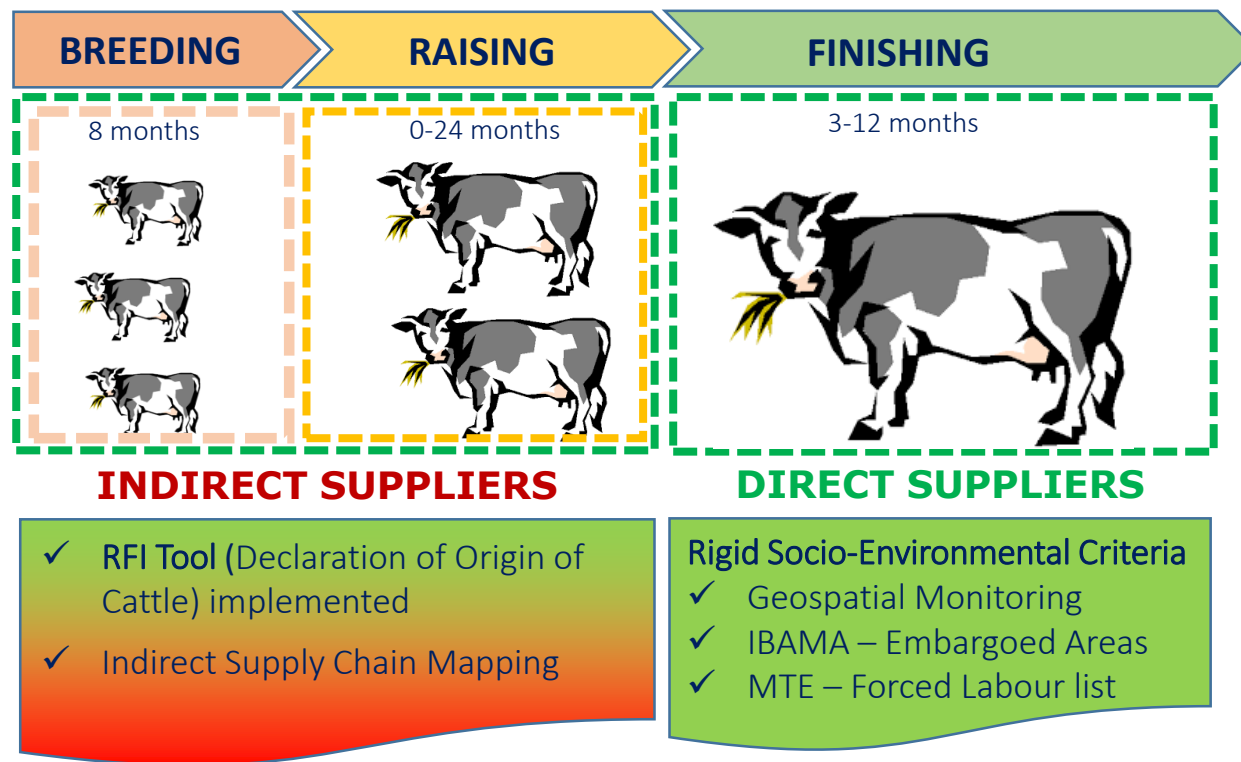

Cattle Purchases in the Amazon Biome in 2015 ✓

- ✓ Zero non-compliance
- ✓ 4 audited plants in the states of MT, RO and PA
- ✓ 100 % of farms with map boundaries (MRV)
- ✓ 100 % of cattle purchases with CAR (environmental licenses)* in the states of Mato Grosso (MT) and Para (PA)
- ✓ Implemented actions for indirect suppliers (RFI Tool)
